- HOWARD STREET TO BE TWO WAY VEHICULAR TRAFFIC, NORTH OF THE LIBRARY ENTRANCE TO BE CLOSED TO VEHICULAR TRAFFIC
- FOOD VENDORS, COFFEE CARTS, SATELLITE CARTS FOR EXISTING RESTAURANTS ON HOWARD (DURING LUNCHTIME, EVENTS AND MIDDAY)
- VEHICULAR DROP OFF AT LIBRARY ENTRANCE, LIBRARY ENTRANCE ACCESS STAIR TO BE RECONFIGURED TO INCREASE ENTRANCE VISIBILITY
