### As a Lifeguard, you will:

- Be a first responder in emergencies throughout a state of the art facility.
- Have the primary responsibility and duty to act in both dry land and aquatic emergencies.
- Make an impact by providing preventative care and watchfulness through observation during aquatic programming.
- Enhance patron relations through professional, friendly and consistent interactions.
- Maintain the functionality of the facility through secondary custodial duties.
- Maintain your knowledge, competency and lifeguarding skills through staff training sessions.
- Be dedicated and timely for the entirety of all shifts assigned and be rescue ready at all times.
- Keep up to date with facility policy and Lifeguard education curriculum

### As a team member, you will:

- Have the benefit of a free Membership to the Aquatic and Fitness Center (5-hours average of work a week required)
- Wear provided uniform attire (staff uniform and personal protective equipment provided by Aquatics Department).
- Be attentive and aware of all swimmers participating in programming while monitoring safety and risks while lifeguarding.
- Represent your team through positive and professional encounters with all patrons and swimmers.
- Educate patrons and swimmers of Facility Rules and expectations during all facility programming.
- Be calm, collected and ready to act in any form of emergency that may happen at the facility.
- Maintain a level of physical fitness and strong swimming skills to be able to proficiently complete
- Report all incidents and complete all appropriate scheduling paperwork in a timely manner.

### As an applicant, you will:

- Have a current American Red Cross Lifeguard certification or equivalent certification (Starguard, Ellis). If not Red Cross certified, be willing to and successfully complete the ARC Lifeguard Crossover course within 30 days of hire.
- Be willing to expand your knowledge in aquatic careers through gaining a certification as an ARC WSI or earning an ARC Lifeguard Trainer certification, if applicable.
- Be proficient and able to demonstrate upon interview in all lifeguarding prerequisites and exit components as required by ARC Certification Standards
