V.CPRD Current Projects & Trail Plans (Casey Creighton)

- 0. Riley Property needs maps & signage not really currently open to public
 - 0. Lack of water well is 1.5 gallons per minute
 - 1. Will most likely need a master plan in the next few years
 - 2. 346 acres 86 acres farmed
 - 3. Opportunities for smaller trails off main trail
- Shaad Park needs some maintenance Has a Master Plan? additional land grants?

- 2. Current trails that need signage etc.
- 3. Bypass Trail taking time needs help not a lot of staff available
 - Volunteers: ADEC, George Fox (corrections crew has been lost),
 community service workers
 - Phase 2 (14th and River to Dundee) this Summer hoping for the whole trail in one stage need 5.9 million
 - ODOT right away properties no properties to obtain, or to get permission to use – just need the funds & design
 - 3. Bridges (2)
 - 4. Will tie into several parks
- 4. Heritage Trails started in 2009 lots of opportunities
- 5. Maintenance have tried several things (gravel only for drainage, bark)
 - 0. Wetlands trouble with the winter months Ewing has faired well this winter
- Bridge at Ewing under plan opening up 11 acres County approval could be an issue
 - O. City to expand UGB would try to expand, but permits are an issue with the mixed County/City
 - 1. Plan to expand disc golf and place a trail around the outside
 - 2. Ewing has a Master Plan parking, concession
- Master Plan is currently being updated goal would be to have the County adopt

- 8. River property 93 acres boat launch and trails along the river
 - 0. ODOT did lots of work for bypass
 - 1. Wetlands planted by HS Kids, etc.

- Farmers have been contacted seem to approve so long as there is a buffer
- Sander Estate expensive cost analysis \$4.5 million will need to be done in phases
- 10. Knudsen Property near Crabtree Park
- 11. Lindquist Property Kayak Launch possibility city of Dundee has some kind of easement down there – are building a trail of Fullquartz – housing is probably going in to the area
