

Newberg Pickleball Club and CPRD Pickleball Advisory Committee

Progress Report

August 18, 2022

The goals of both of these groups are the same, they are:

- Support and grow the Pickleball community for all ages
- Create and improve facilities for year-round usage
- Drive the economic results that will support the sport and benefit the community

Our achievements:

- We became a chapter of the Columbia River Pickleball Club (about 1000 members) a year ago with 42 initial members and today we have over 80 with new player/member participation growing weekly
- We have gained broad community support from Business (Chehalem Valley Chamber of Commerce), Tourism (Taste Newberg) and our largest healthcare provider (Providence Hospital).
- We are actively promoting and sponsoring tournaments and community training events.
- We have actively pursued all grant funding opportunities – two submissions to date
- We maintain the courts we play on, we have paid for all new nets, balls, and storage containers - \$2k
- We have a complete understanding of all CPRD financial information and the availability of their public funds
- We have CPRD's agreement and purchase of materials to over paint all Pickleball court lines at Jacquith and reconfigure and paint 12 new courts

Our next steps:

- Deliver to the CPRD board a modified version of their 2022-2023 budget that includes a 12 court covered Pickleball facility with gravel parking for 200 cars located CPRD property on Wilsonville road utilizing a portion of the \$7M dollars in funds, liquid assets, they have on hand and are not being utilized.
