1. **Meeting Called to Order.** *Lance motions, Sheryl seconds.*
2. **Roll call.**
  - a. All members present except for Gayle Bizeau.
3. **Approval of January Minutes**
  - a. Meeting minutes approved as modified.
    - i. Modification, change “Pull Barn” to “Pole Barn”
  - b. *Mike motions, Nick seconds*
4. **CPRD Form to Reapply for Pickleball Committee**
  - a. It is likely the committee members will need to sign in the future but the form is not currently ready.
5. **Continue discussion regarding Jaquith Proposal**
  - a. The committee would like confirmation on how many total courts will be at Jaquith once the project is complete.
    - i. 14 was mentioned at CPRD board meeting. Potentially 6 covered, and 8 on the tennis courts.
  - b. Nick discusses potential issues of the covered courts not having sides—mainly water getting onto the courts given Oregon winter weather.
  - c. The importance of having a space for people to hang out while they wait their turn to play, put on court shoes, etc. would be important.
    - i. Having this area covered would be great.
6. **Open comment period**
  - a. The Jaquith Park courts has been very busy with the nice weather. On Saturday 2/3, Nick and Lance observed 10 of the 12 courts in use.
  - b. Nick will summarize a “wish List” of everything the Pickleball Advisory Committee believes would be important to consider as CPRD moves forward with a budget for the project.

- i. Nick will share this with the Pickleball Advisory Committee via email for comment and approval.
- c. Lighting will be an important consideration for the facility.
- d. Humidity and condensation can be big issues in Oregon, and they should be considered. Having covered courts that are too wet to safely play on would be unfortunate.
- e. Julie will initiate a meeting with Bryan Stewart and Casey Creighton prior to March 1<sup>st</sup> to discuss the Pickleball Advisory Committee's "wish list" prior to budgets being due.
