Introduction

Chehalem Park and Recreation District (CPRD) released a community input survey which accepted responses from September 19, 2025, through October 31, 2025. During that time period 829 responses were collected. The following report provides a description of the survey's objectives, methods used to gather survey responses, an executive summary describing survey results, and a full publication of the survey's questions and results.

Survey Objectives

CPRD released a community input survey to better understand:

- What our residents value about local park and recreation opportunities;
- Which park facilities and recreation programs people are using today;
- Where CPRD should invest additional resources into parks, facilities, and programs that we already have; and
- What CPRD should do to make park and recreation opportunities better for everyone in the future.

Survey Methods

The community input survey used a mixed methodology for collection of responses from the public. Response collection used in this survey included:

- Direct mail with printed QR code sent via United States Postal Service to all households within the District boundaries;
- District website information on homepage and designated webpage;
- Press releases to local media contacts resulting in publication of the survey in two (2) local newspapers (Newberg Graphic and Newsberg);
- Five (5) posts on CPRD's Facebook and Instagram social media channels;
- Placement of QR codes and url for online access within Board of Directors' public meeting materials during the survey period, and
- Placement of hard copy surveys at high traffic CPRD facilities including the Chehalem Aquatic and Fitness Center, Senior Center, and Chehalem Glenn Golf Course Clubhouse.

The 2025 community input survey is not considered a statistically valid survey. The methodology did not rely on a recognized sampling method, no verification of sample size adequacy was conducted, it was not verified as reducing bias in sample questions, and margin of error within the responses collected is unknown.

Executive Summary

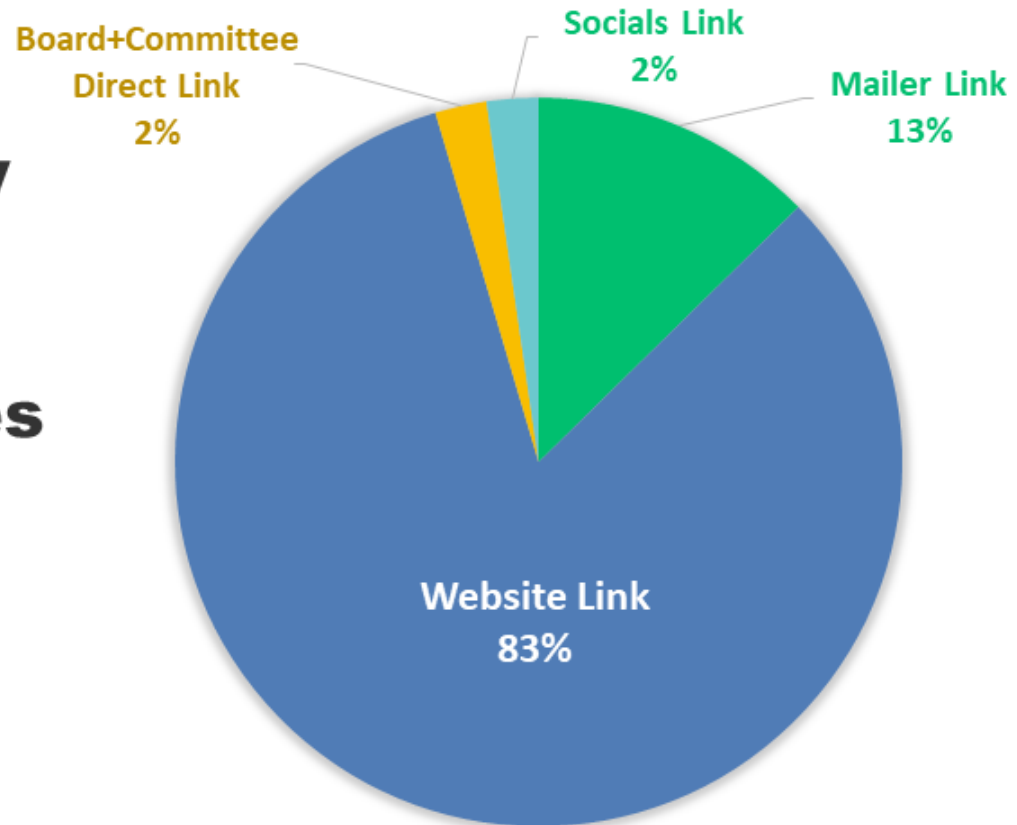


Figure 1. Number of Responses and Source for 2025 Community Input Survey Results

Chehalem Park and Recreation District (CPRD) opened a public input survey on September 19, 2025, which remained open for 42 days. The survey closed on October 31, 2025, with a total of 829 survey responses collected. The survey questions were organized to meet the major objectives of understanding respondents' familiarity with CPRD and its facilities and services, understanding the importance that respondents place on existing CPRD facilities and services, and understanding the importance that respondents place on priority projects that CPRD may develop in the future. Figures 1 through 18 depict the results of questions occurring throughout the survey.

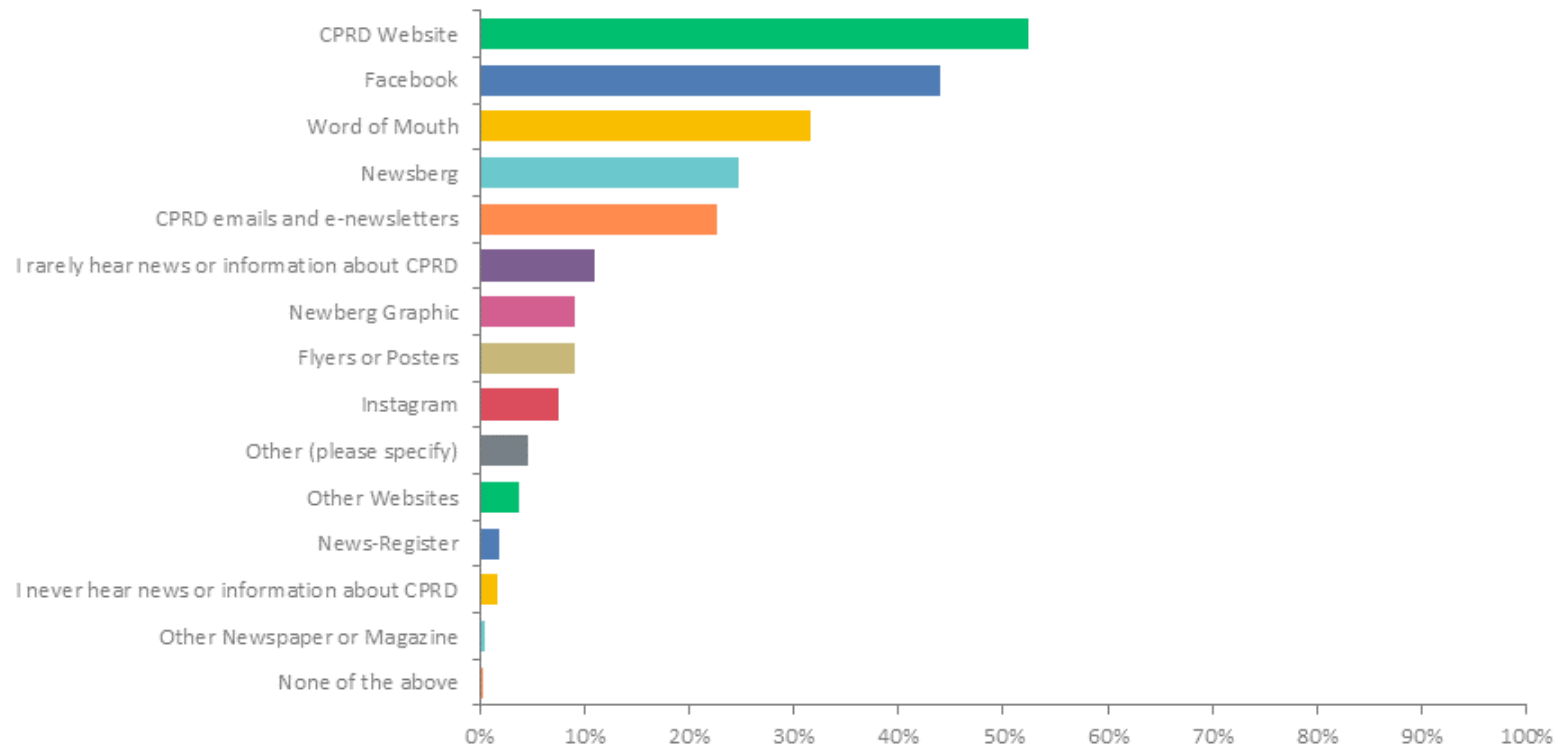


Figure 2. Information Sources for Park and Recreation Information (Q1)

As shown in Figures 1 and 2, a majority of respondents completed the survey using CPRD's website and CPRD's website is where the majority of respondents (52.5%) typically find information about park and recreation opportunities. Other common sources of information amongst respondents included Facebook, word of mouth, Newsberg, and direct emails from CPRD.

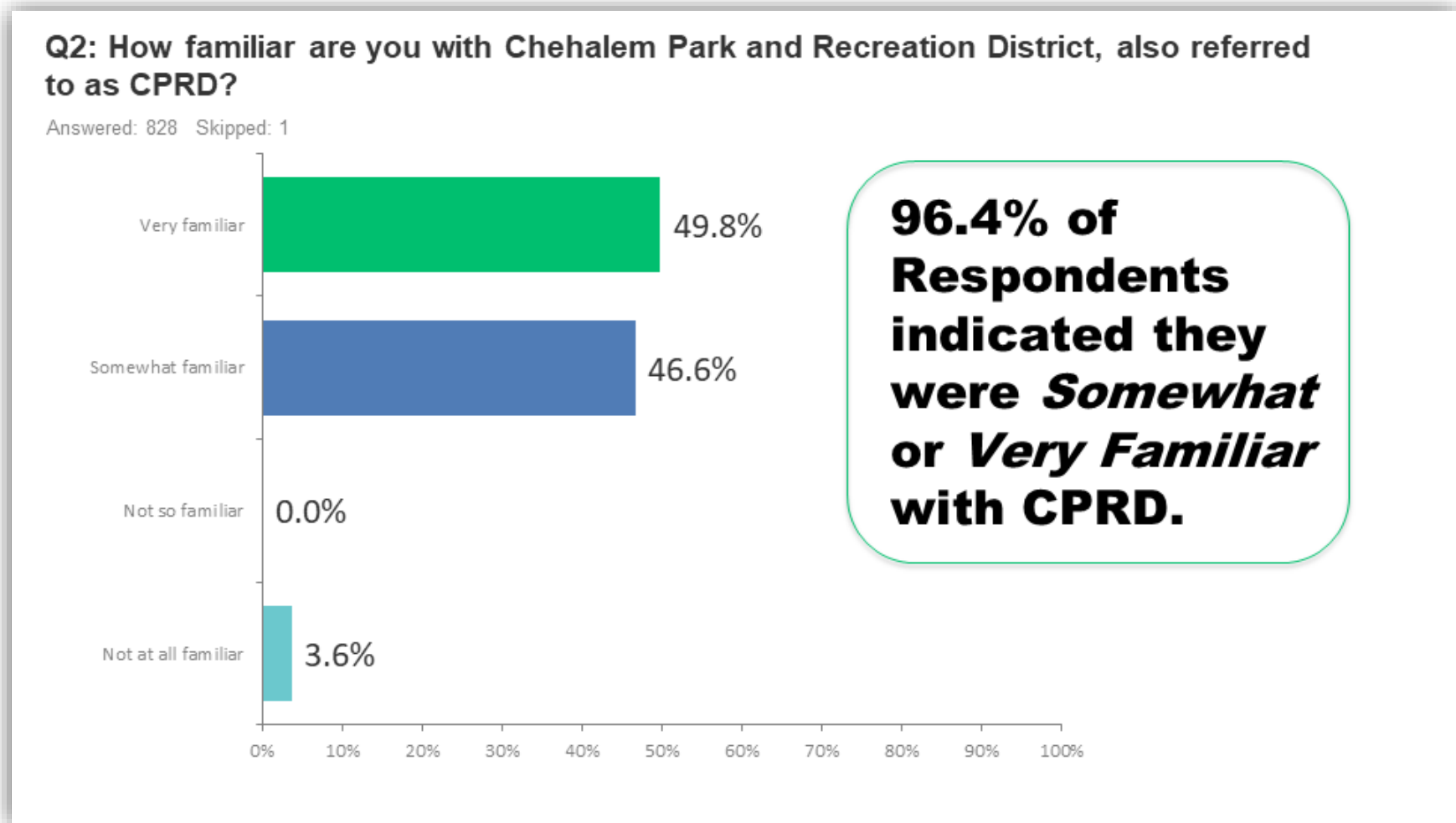


Figure 3. Familiarity with Chehalem Park and Recreation District (Q2)

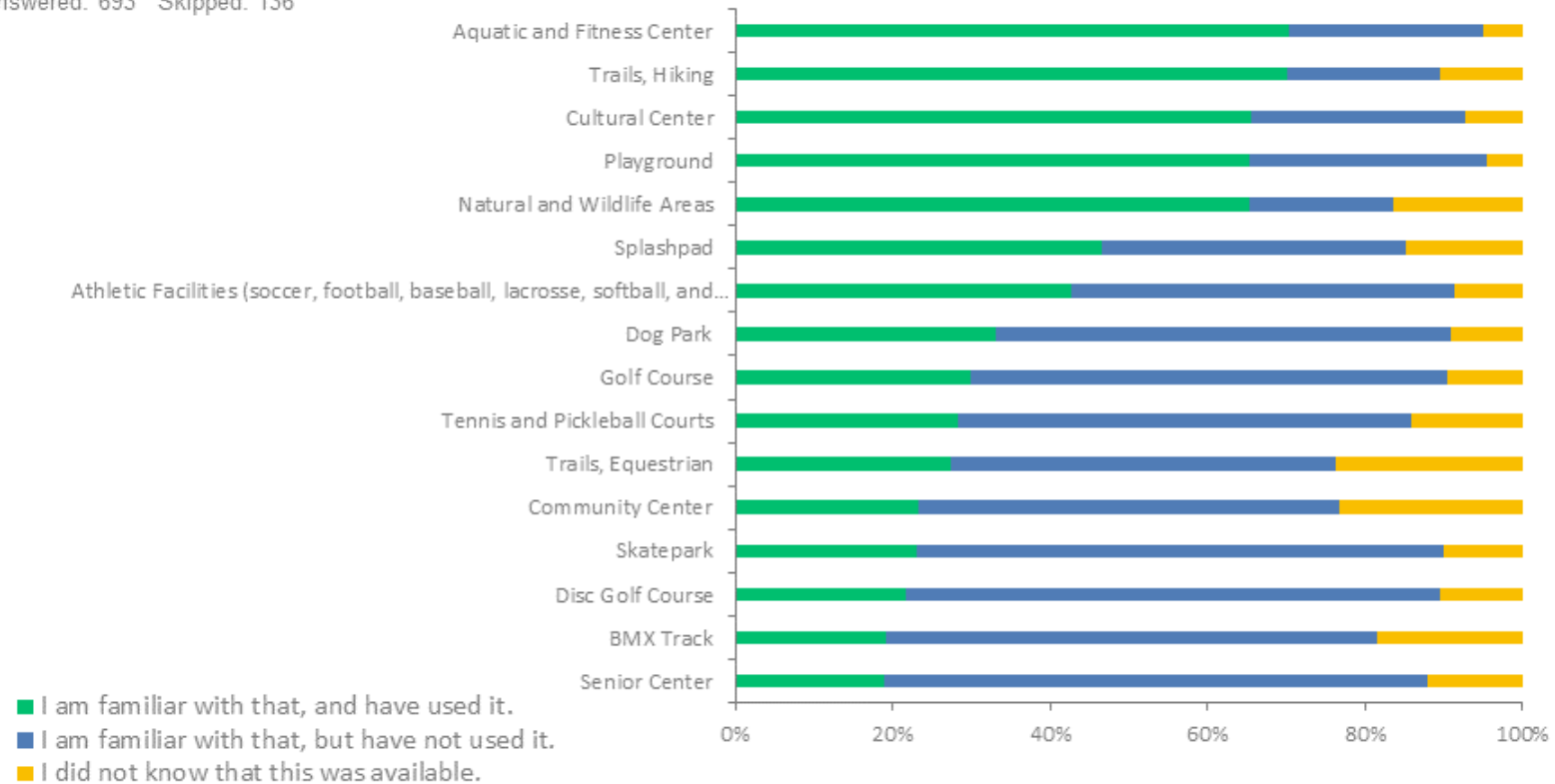


Figure 5. Familiarity with Current Parks and Facilities (Q5)

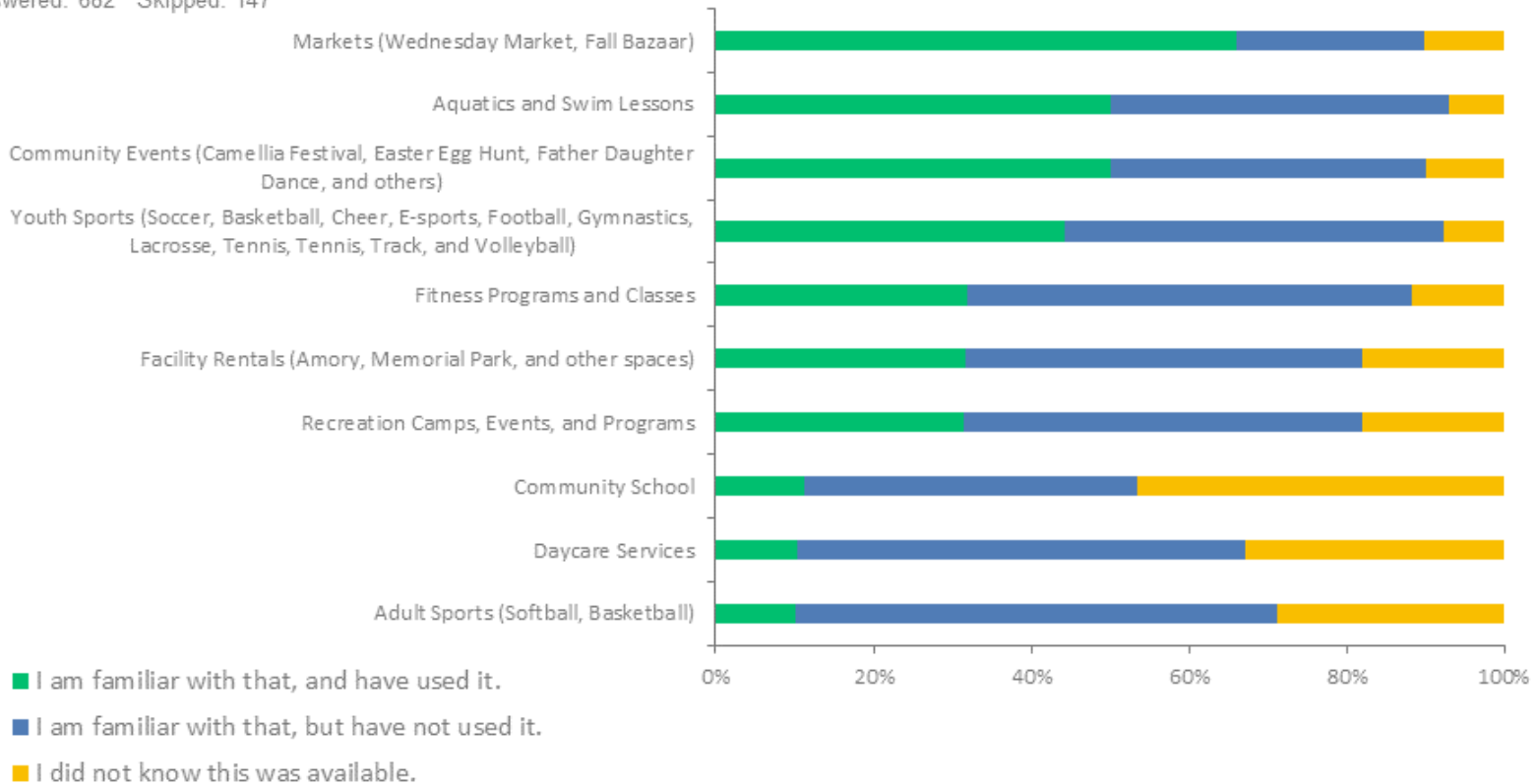


Figure 6. Familiarity with Current Recreation Programs, Camps, and Activities (Q6)

As shown in Figure 3, survey results indicated that 96.4% of respondents were *Very Familiar* or *Somewhat Familiar* with CPRD. However, the survey was completed by only a limited number of people — 3.6% of respondents — who indicated they were *Not So Familiar* or *Not At All Familiar* with CPRD. Highest levels of respondent familiarity with parks and facilities were demonstrated with Cultural Center, hiking trails, playgrounds, and Aquatic and Fitness Center as depicted in Figure 5. Respondent's familiarity with programmatic offerings indicated that highest levels occurred with market-related events, aquatics programs and classes, and community events as depicted in Figure 6. Results indicated that 72.5% of respondents visit local parks or recreation facilities one or more times per week. Results indicated that 44.1% of respondents use or participate in recreation programs or activities one or more times per week.

Respondents noted their overall satisfaction with CPRD's parks, facilities, and programs as 3.7 out of 5, falling somewhere within the range of *Adequate* to *Pretty Good* as shown in Figure 4. However, respondents gave a slightly higher satisfaction rating — 3.9 out of 5 — for local park and facility maintenance.

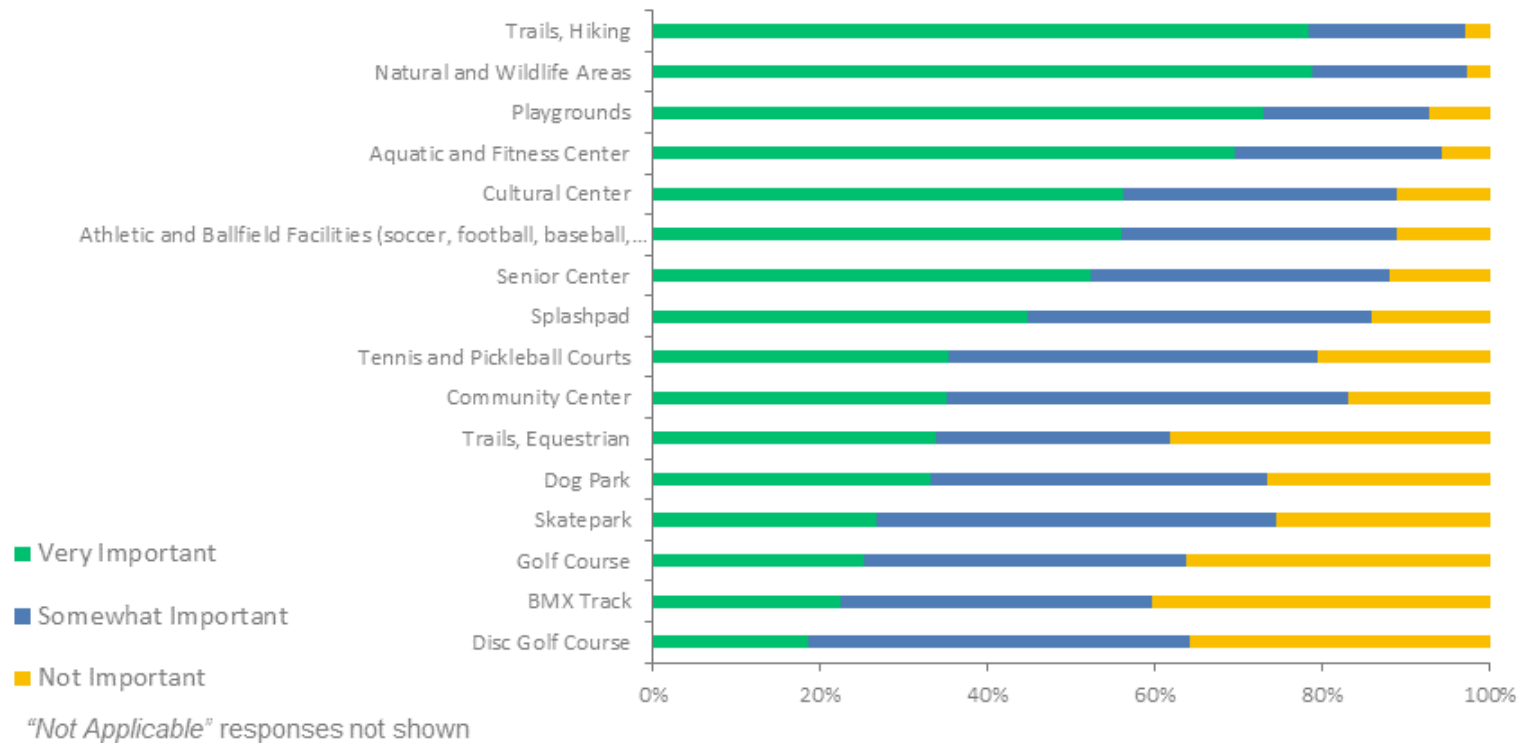


Figure 7. Importance of Park and Recreation Facilities (Q7)

As shown in Figure 7, respondents rated Hiking Trails, Natural and Wildlife Areas, and the Aquatic and Fitness Centers as those of highest importance. Respondents expressed lower levels of importance for facilities that were more specialized in nature including BMX Track, Equestrian Trails, Golf, and Disc Golf facilities. As shown in Figure 9, respondents placed the highest levels of importance on Youth Sports and Market-related programs, while placing somewhat lower levels of importance on Daycare Services, Community School, and Adult Sports. Where the survey asked respondents to select their household's favorite activity, respondents' most frequently selected activities were Hiking (11.6%), Bicycling (10.7%), Horseback Riding / Equestrian (9.4%), Swimming, and Playgrounds (7.7%) as shown in Figure 11. It is noted that additional

activities were written into the *Other* response which included a high number of Mountain Biking write-in's.

As shown in Figure 15, the survey asked respondents to consider potential new projects which were related to the Board of Directors' Strategic Planning Priorities (2025) goals and objectives. Highest levels of support — including *Very Important* and *Somewhat Important* — were demonstrated for replacement or rehabilitation of aging playgrounds at multiple parks (87.2%), additional hiking trails (87.0%), construction of a multi-use trail connecting Newberg and Dundee (82.5%), and additional river access for non-motorized watercraft (79.5%). A majority of respondents indicated that a limited number of potential new projects were *Not Important* including additional equestrian trails (51.5%) and development of a new clubhouse and additional nine holes of golf at Chehalem Glenn Golf Course (62.5%).

Depicted in Figure 13, when asked about what prevents respondents from using park facilities or participating in recreation activities, 21% of respondents indicated *Not enough*

scheduled time / Not available when I have time. When asked which group(s) of people need more or improved facilities and services, respondents provided most support for *Teens (13-17)* at 44.6% followed by *Youth (12 and under)* at 33.9%.

The survey included multiple open-ended questions (Q3, Q8, Q11, and Q15) that asked people to share an item of high importance regarding a valued facility or program, or an opportunity for improvement. In each case, hundreds of qualitative responses were provided that spanned an immense number of topics, requests, and suggestions. Common themes that were observed in these responses included:

- Comments regarding the importance of maintaining or improving quality at existing facilities;
- Multiple user groups advocating for installation of a bathroom at Ewing Young Park including the BMX, skateboarding, dog park, and hiking enthusiasts;
- High levels of frustration by the mountain biking community regarding loss of trail access and a failure to replace this recreational option within the District in a timely manner;
- High satisfaction with trail access by equestrian users, often paired with appreciation for perceived reductions in conflict with other users and overall safety improvement;
- Desire to retain affordability in pricing;
- Desire to expand diversity of programming options;
- Comments regarding playground improvements related to inclusive and special needs oriented design including requests that mentioned fencing, sound/noise reduction, surfacing, and other features;
- Comments regarding the Newberg Old Fashion Festival which almost exclusively referenced the festival's fireworks show;
- Differing perspectives on swimming pool utilization and access including comments calling for more public swim time as well as comments requesting more club/group swim time; and
- Comments referencing maintenance non-CPRD owned facilities or programs operated by other entities.

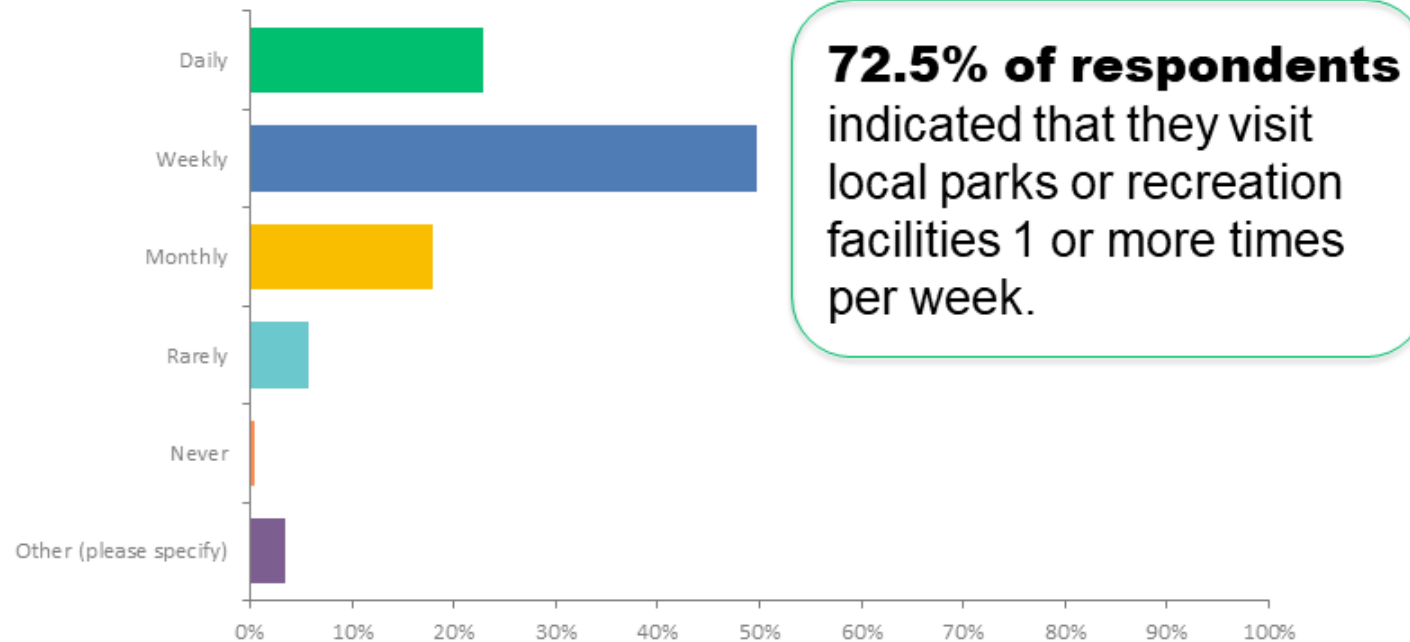


Figure 8. Frequency of Park and Facility Visitation (Q9)

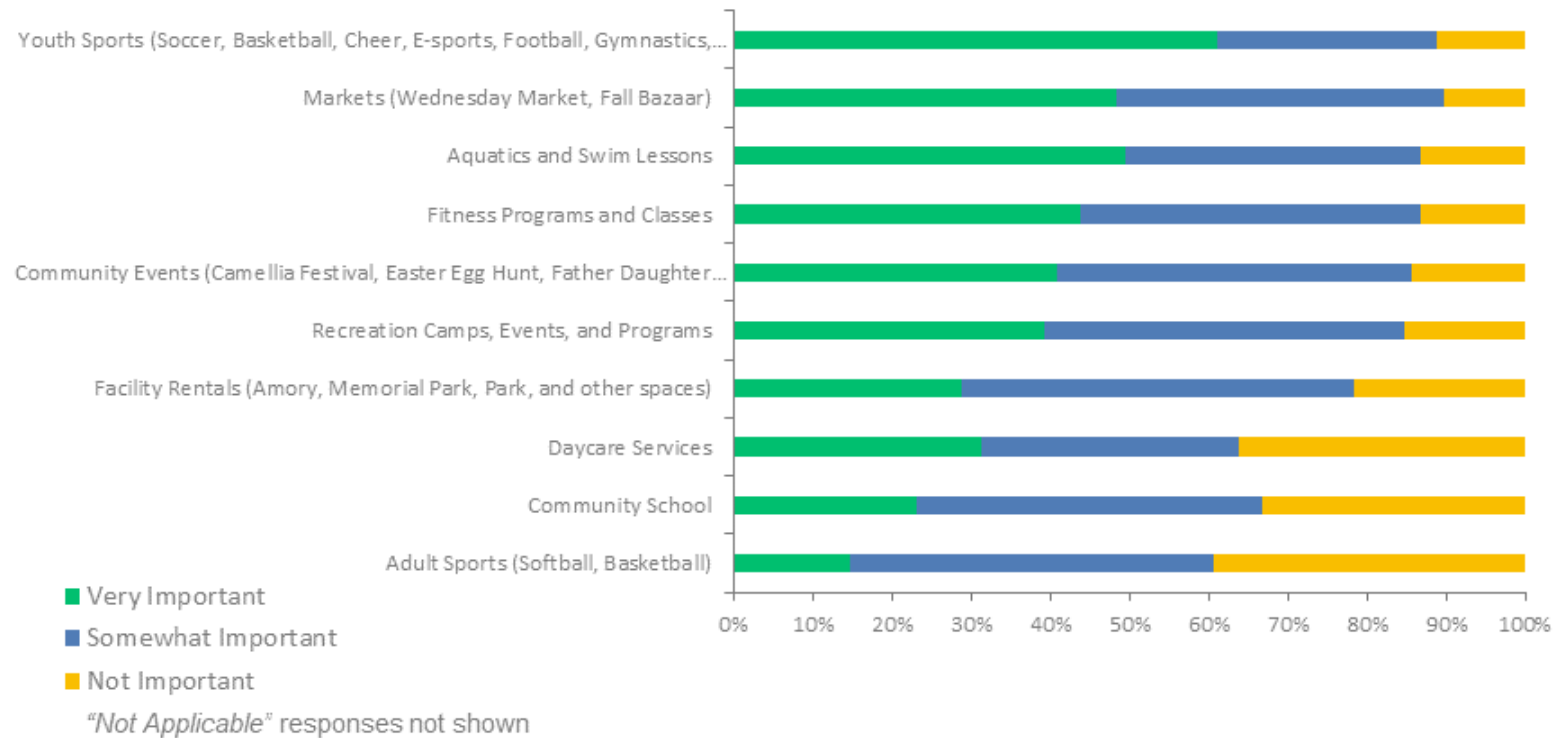


Figure 9. Importance of Recreation Programs and Activities (Q10)

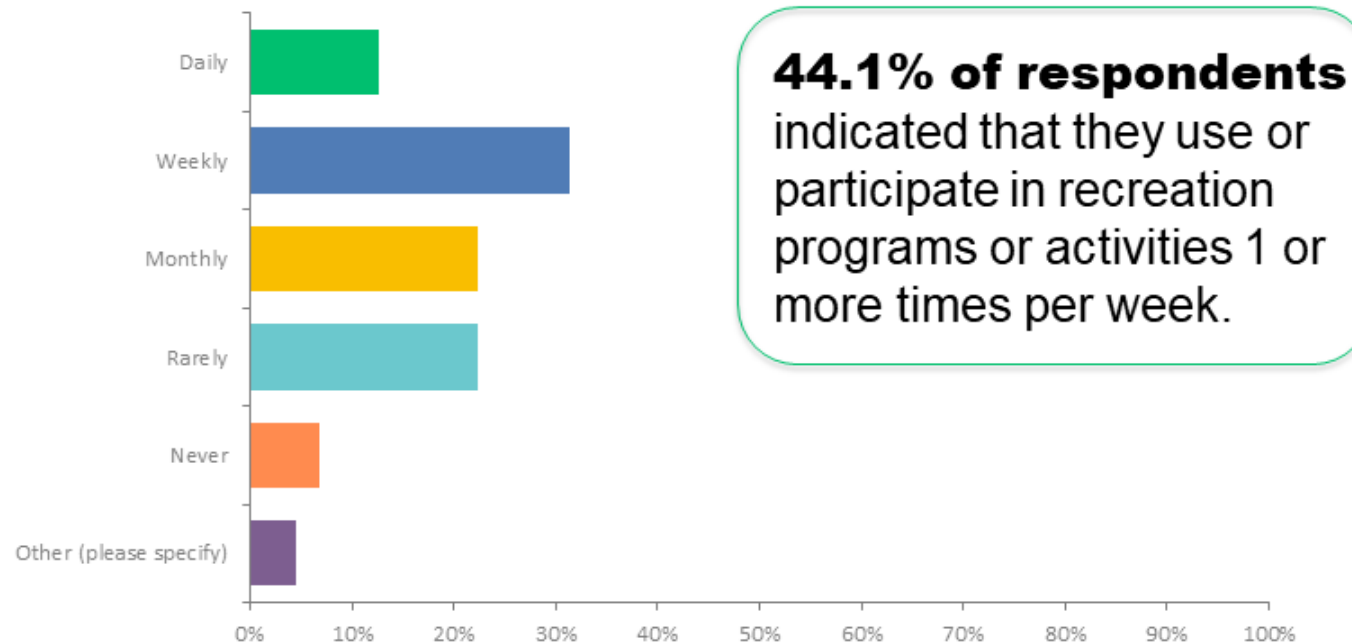


Figure 10. Frequency of Participation in Recreation Programs (Q12)

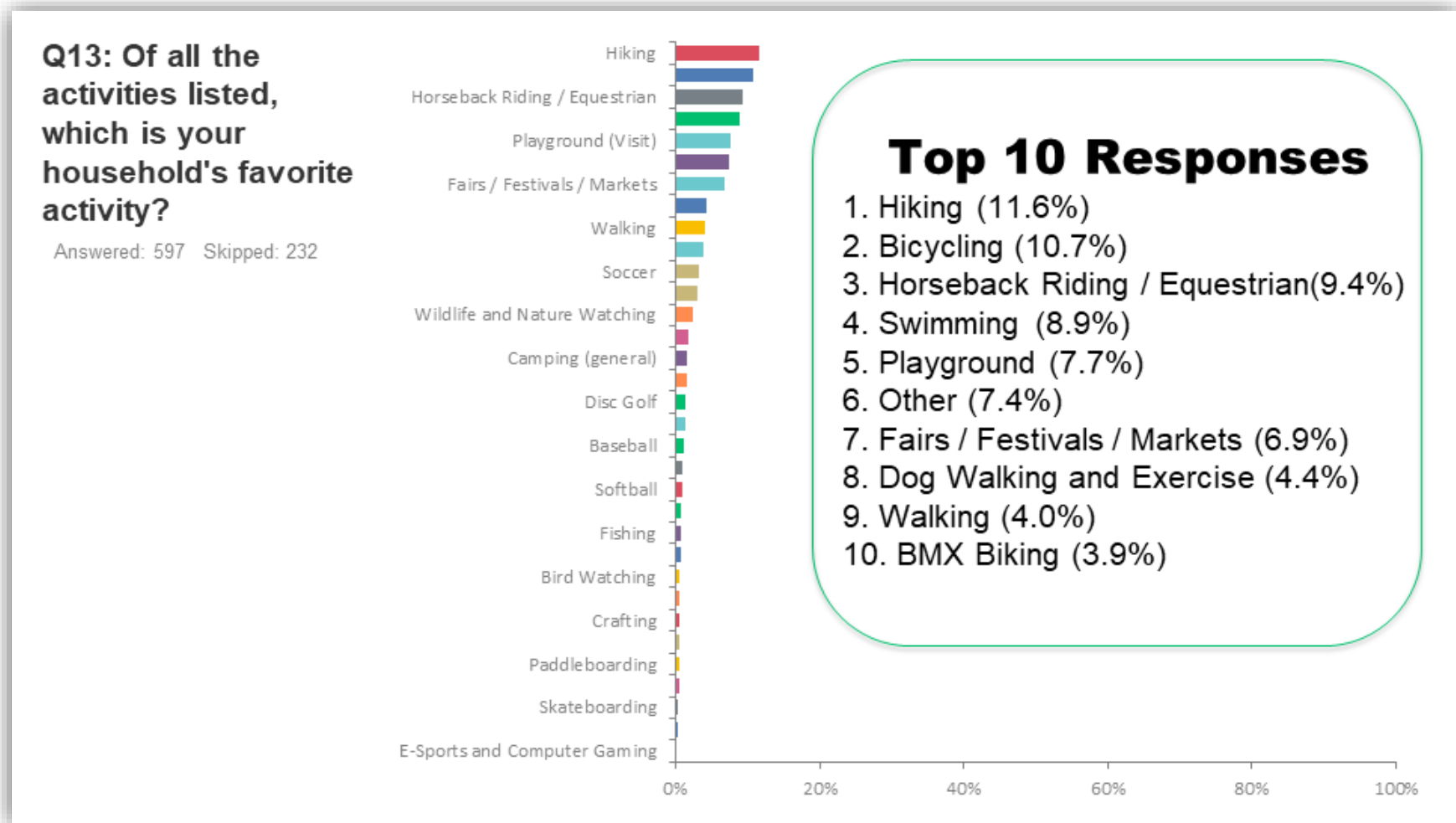


Figure 11. "Favorite" Activities for Respondents' Households (Q13)

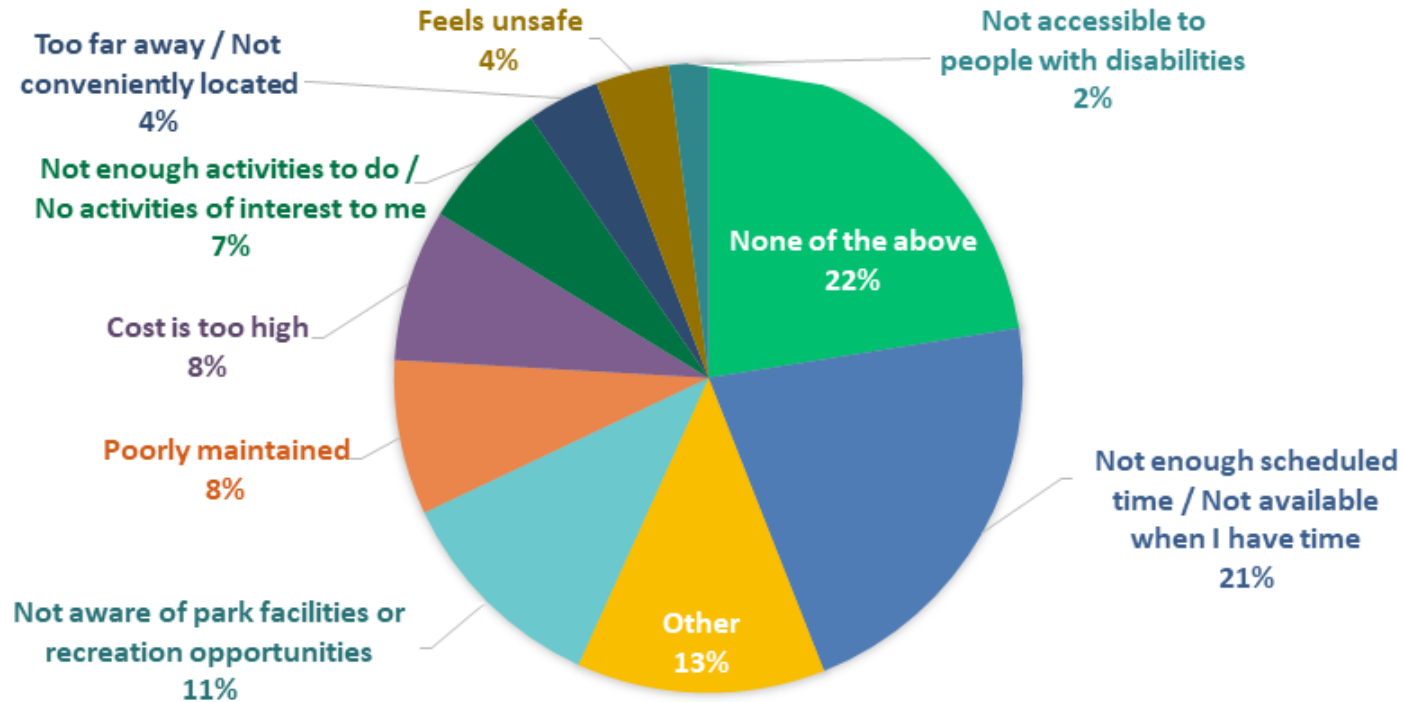


Figure 13. Barriers to Facilities and Participation (Q16)

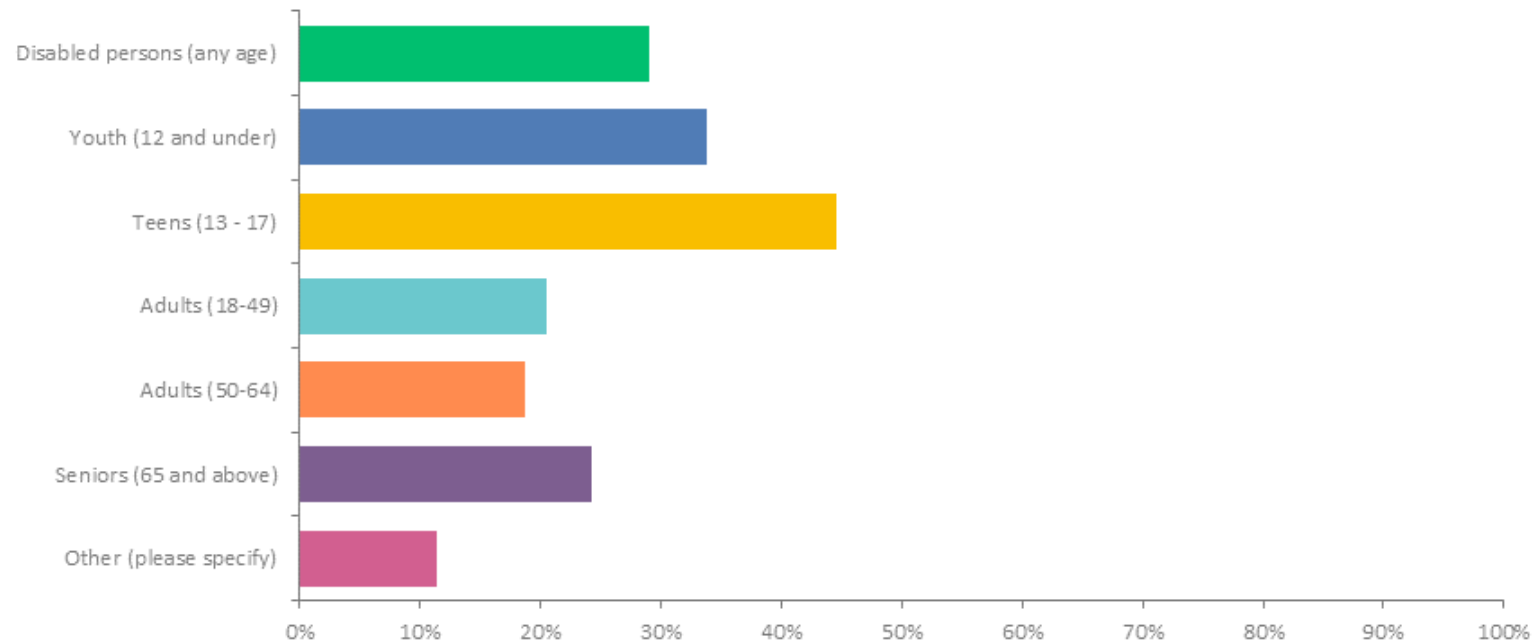


Figure 14. Perceived User Need (Q17)

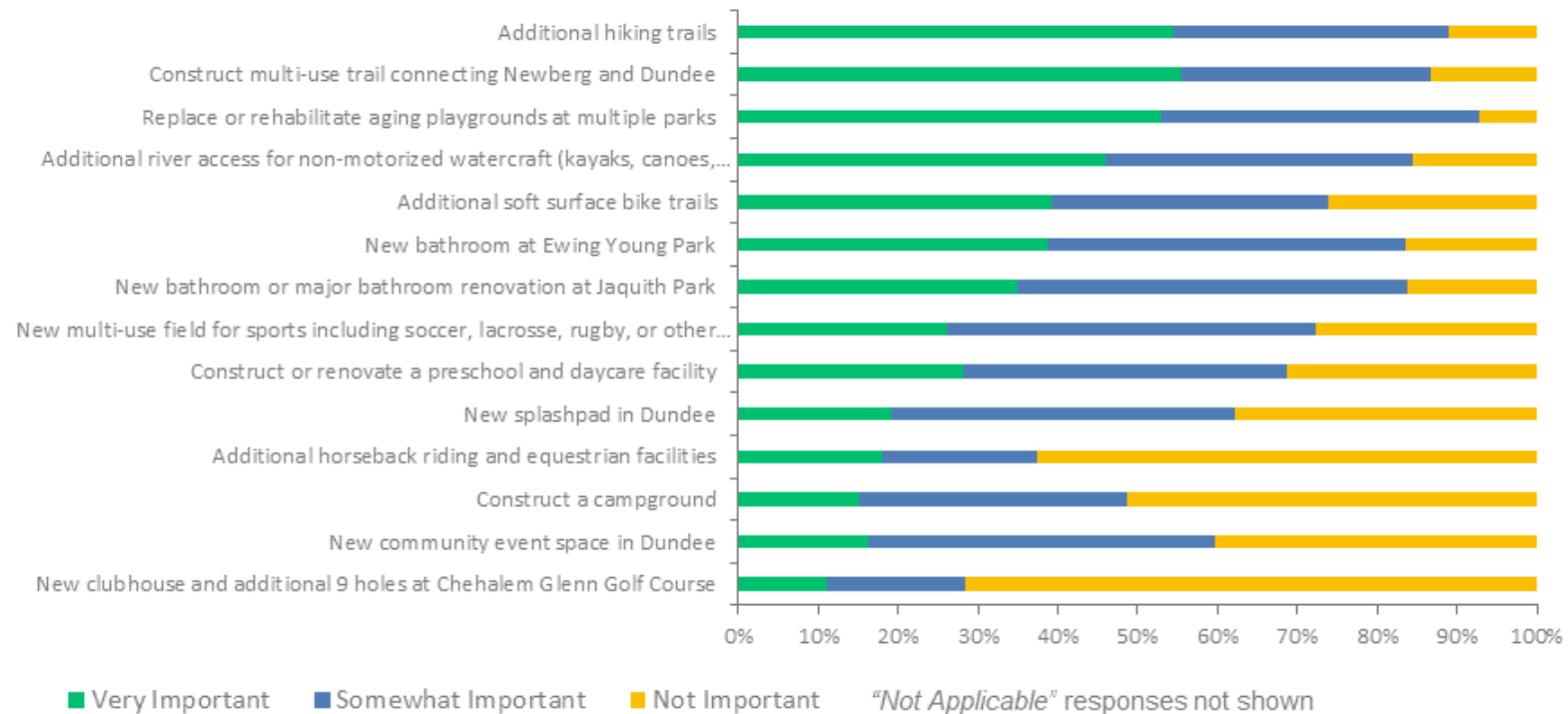


Figure 15. Importance of CPRD Initiatives and Priorities (Q18)

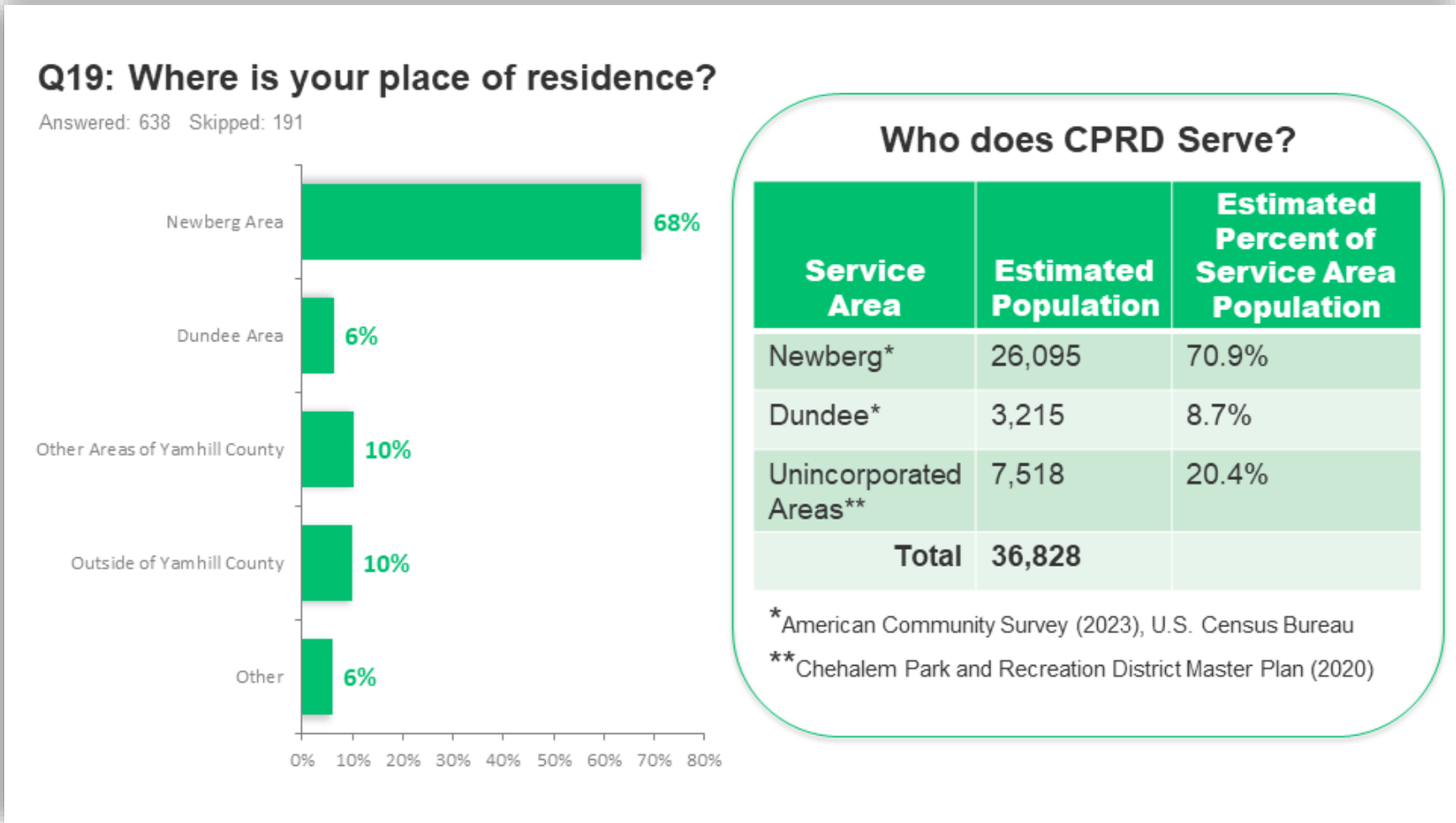


Figure 16. Respondent Place of Residence (Q19) and Local Demographics

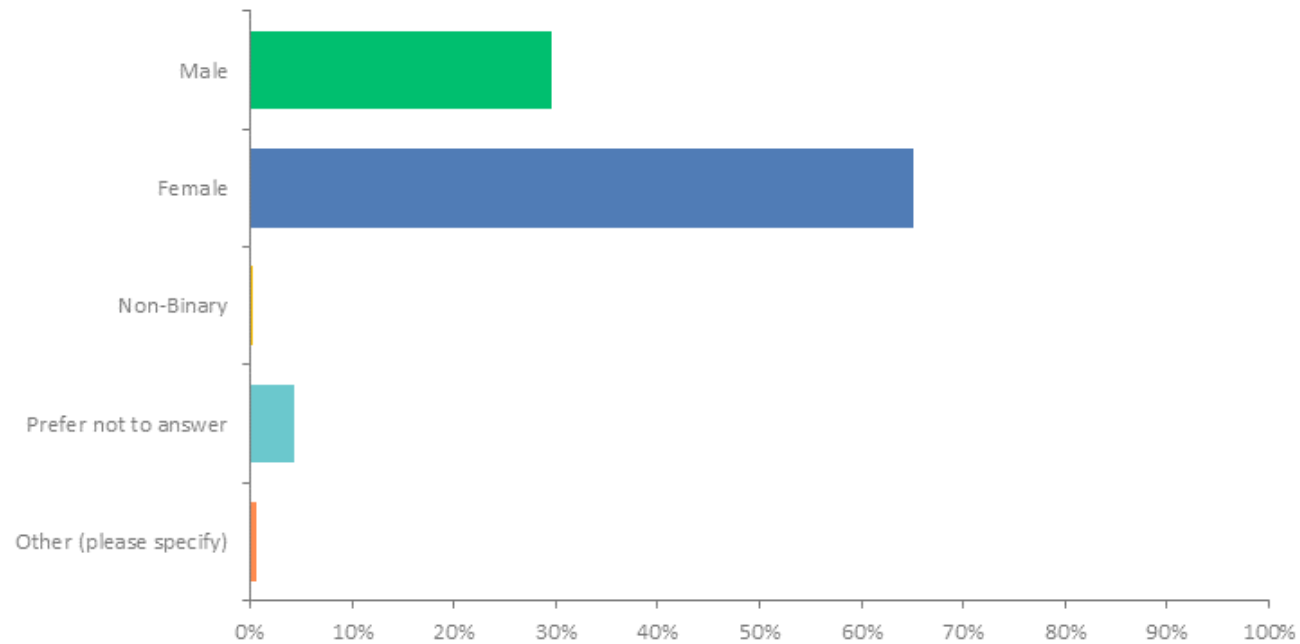


Figure 17. Gender of Respondents (Q21)

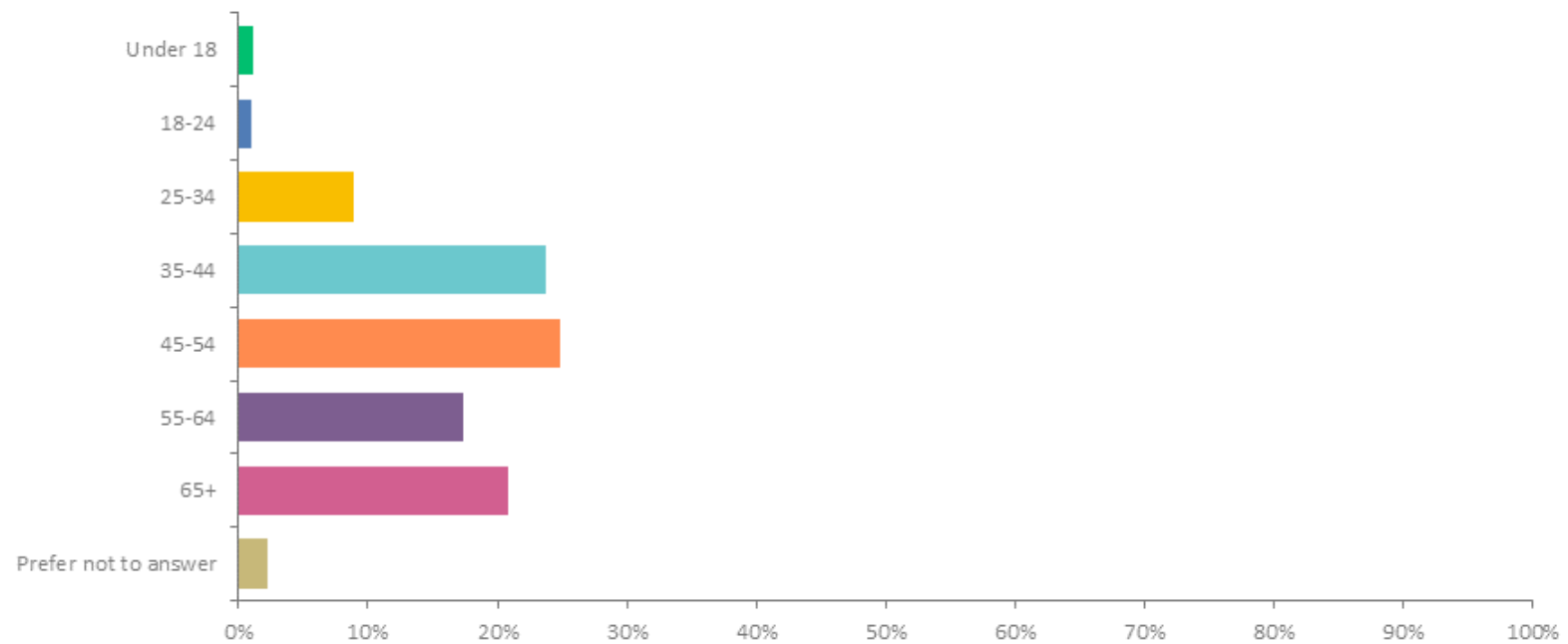


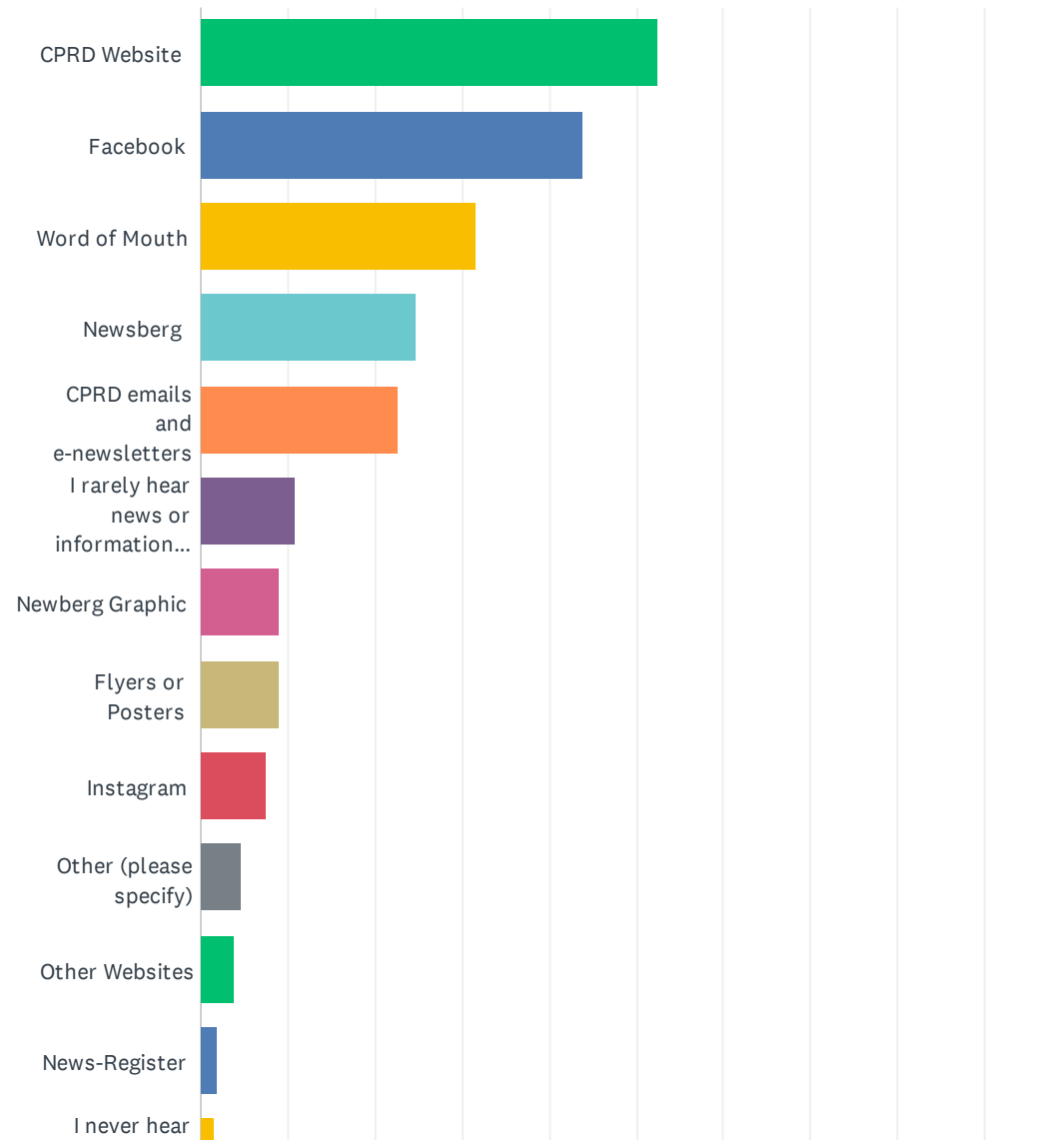
Figure 18. Age of Respondents

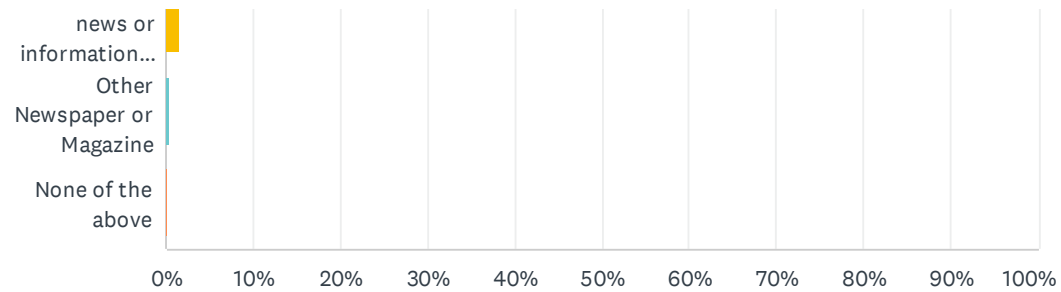

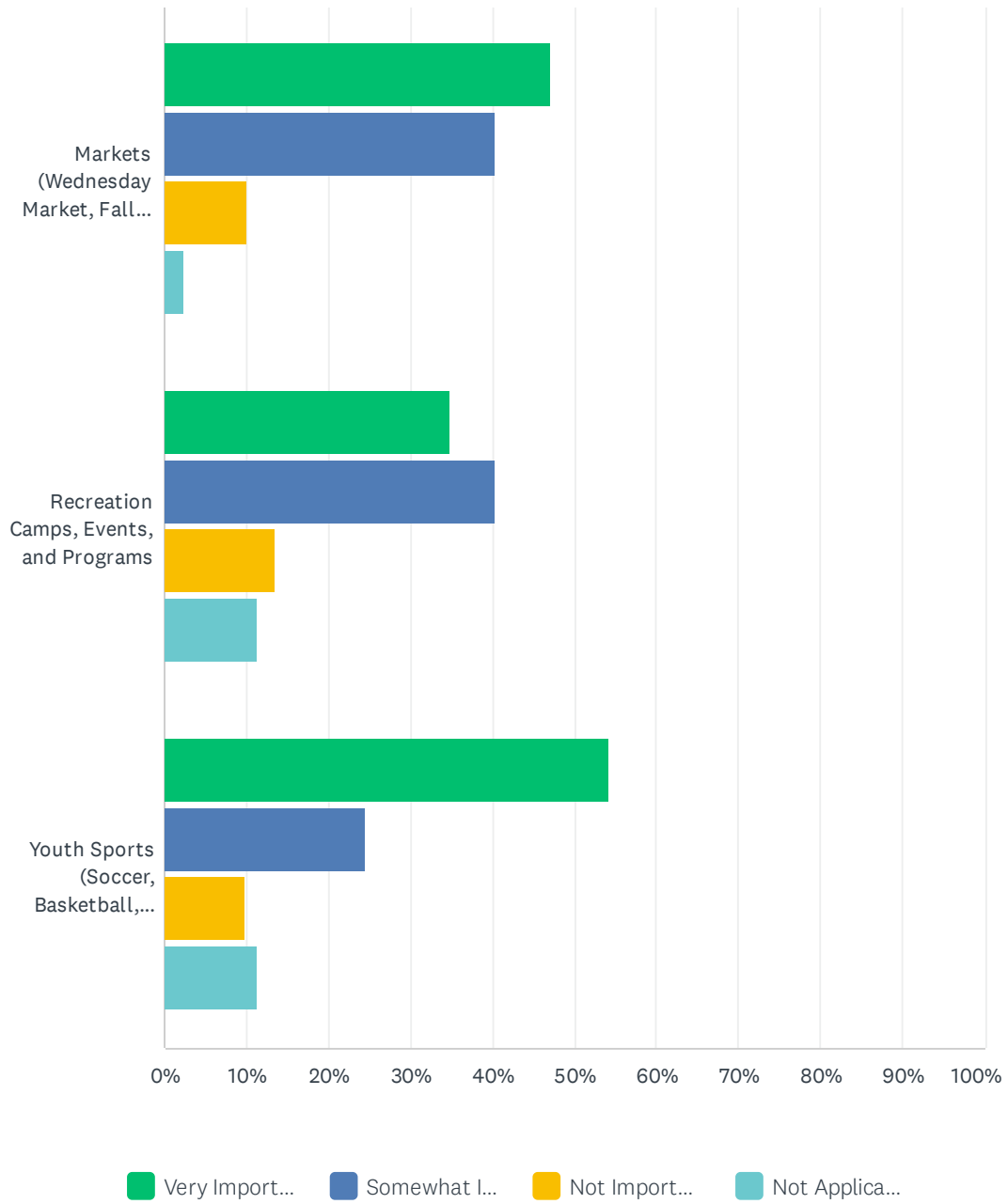

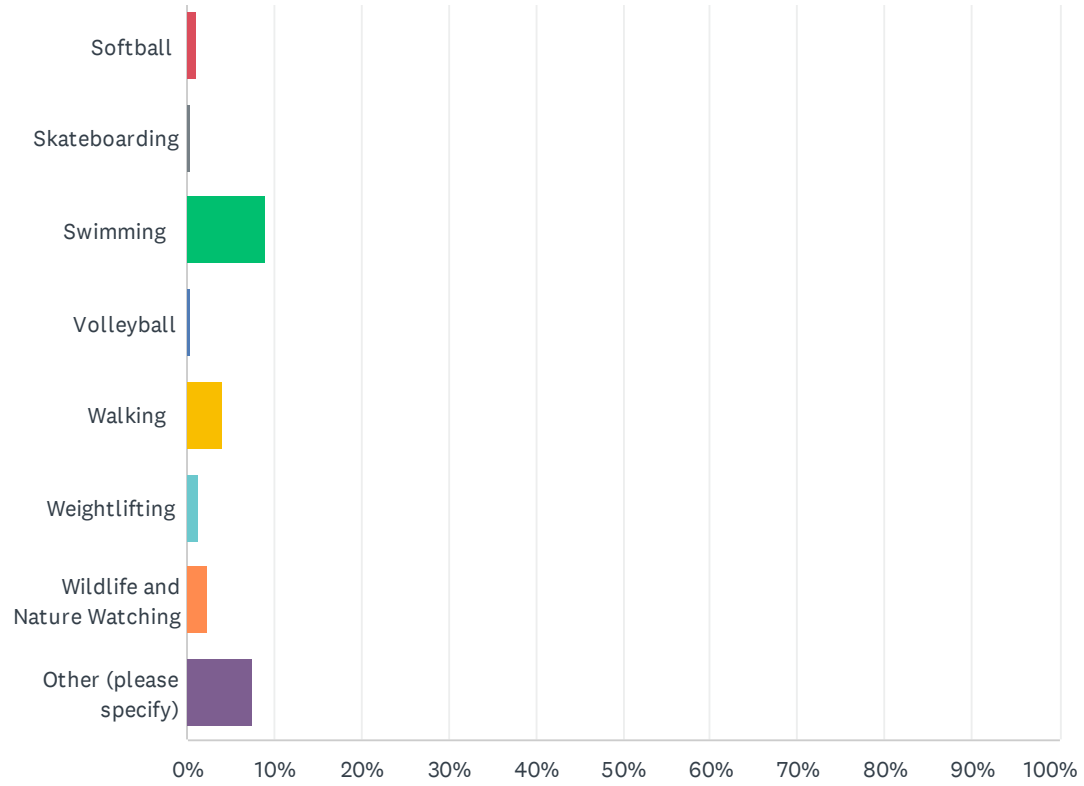
