

- 4 **Bob & Crystal Rilee Park Trails**
10500 NE Parrett Mountain Rd.
Roughly 12 miles of woodland hiking trails with designated access for equestrians and mountain bicyclists during dry months of the year.
- 5 **Central Newberg Sidewalk Trails**
114 S. River St.
4.5 mi. Sidewalk routes connecting highlights throughout downtown and Chehalam Cultural District.
- 6 **The Green Thumb Trail at Crabtree Park**
Worden Hill Rd. • Dundee
An easy, 1.9 mile wooded trail along a hillside in an idyllic setting.

- 1 **Chehalam Glenn Golf Course Trails**
4501 E. Fernwood Rd.
Almost 4 mostly flat miles on woodchips, forest floor, and some sidewalks.
- 2 **Schaad Park Loop Trail**
Eagle St.
Just under 1 mile, switchbacks up a steep elevation to scenic viewpoint.
- 3 **Ewing Young Park Trails**
1201 S. Blaine St.
About 1.5 miles of easy-to-moderate woodland trails with sections along Chehalam Creek.
