

CPRD Board Member Larry Anderson addressed the concern of what it would take to make the access legal for CPRD. Currently it is known that application process to change the access from agricultural to something different could be quite expensive. The current formula is listed on the application as the current value of the property today less the appraised commercial value with the new access = the application fee.

It was agreed upon by the board that they are in need of know from ODOT exactly what the application fee would be to change the access from agriculture to an access that would be legal for CPRD to use. Michael Gunn has offered to communicate with ODOT to find out the answer to this specific question. Michael has also requested a time frame in which a meeting can be call between CPRD and Legal Council Allyn Brown to discuss the new communications and 2nd earnest agreement.

CPRD will strive to make the meeting take place in one weeks time noting that Allyn Brown schedule with determine if this time frame is adequate.
